

ALL ARE SINNERS

Romans 3:10,23 As it is written, no one is righteous, not even one.. For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

Where is the offense?

Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man [Adam] sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death came to all men, because all sinned.

This is called **original sin**. Sin was inherited from Adam, and from this sin comes the whole judgment of God, which is called **spiritual death**.

Spiritual death - the separation of soul and spirit, or separation of man from God.

Physical death - is separation of body and soul or death of fleshly part.

What is the wages of sin?

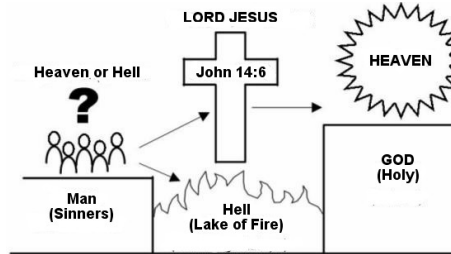
Romans 6:23a For the wages of sin is death

The meaning of this death is spiritual death, not physical death. Because of Adam's sin that we inherited, we died spiritually, and we should be cast into the lake of fire, or hell. But God does not want man to be cast into the lake of fire.

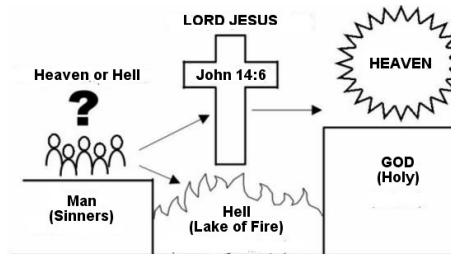
