7. What are the fruits of the Spirit? Try to give them from memory in class.

Tuesday, Wednesday - Read Galatians 6: 1-10

8. What is a Christian to do for a fellow Christian who has stumbled into sin?

9. Verse two tells us to "bear one another's burdens." Name some possible burdens that we could help another bear.

10. Verse five tells us that each "shall bear his own load." Name some burdens which a person must bear alone.
