8. How did Jesus Christ show Peter and Nathaniel that He possessed an attribute of God?

9. What caused John the Baptist's disciples to turn from following John to following Jesus?

10. Which disciples of Jesus were from Bethsaida? Locate Bethsaida on your map.

11. How did Philip explain to Nathaniel whom he believed Jesus to be?

12. What was Nathaniel's response to Philip's declaration?

13. Where was Nathaniel from (See John 21:2)

14. What is the significance of Jesus' telling Nathaniel, "hereafter you shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man?" See also Genesis 28:10-13.

15. Nathaniel called Jesus "the Son of God" in verse 49. How did Jesus refer to Himself, not only in this passage, but throughout the gospels?

16. Why, do you think, did Jesus always refer to Himself in this way? See also Daniel 7:13-14.
